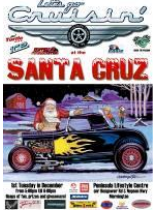




LGC Cruiser Update November 2012

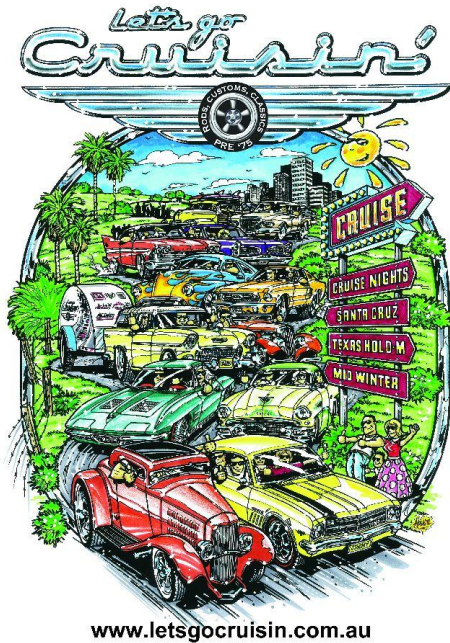
Cruise to Historic Races at Phillip Island. Saturday 9th March

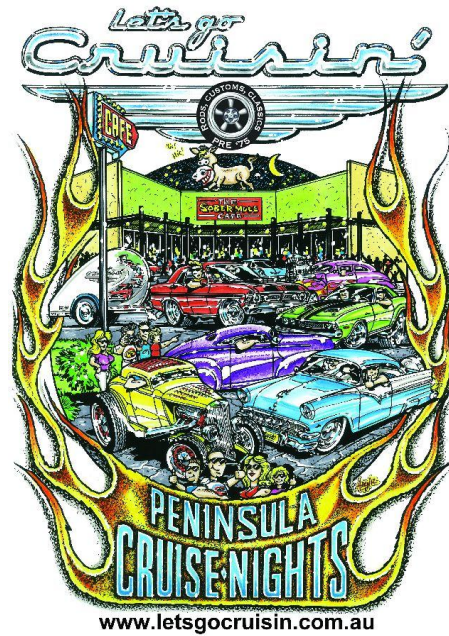
End of Season' Cruise to Beechworth May 4/5th 2013
