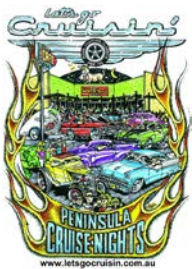

any engine, it's based on a 'seasoned' Vortec 4 bolt block then filled with hi performance crankshaft and rods, forged hi comp pistons, topped off with performance alloy heads, an Edelbrock intake manifold and matched carby. Fitted out with a gear reduction starter and alternator supplied by Mark McDonald Auto Electrical from Carrum Downs, this 'turn key' ready to start engine is expected to produce around 400 BHP. Enough to light the fire in most cars. Valued at around \$7000, this engine is going to be won at next year's March Cruise Night by a very lucky *LGC Cruiser*. Remember there are no raffle tickets to buy and you do not have to be present at the draw to claim this prize.
